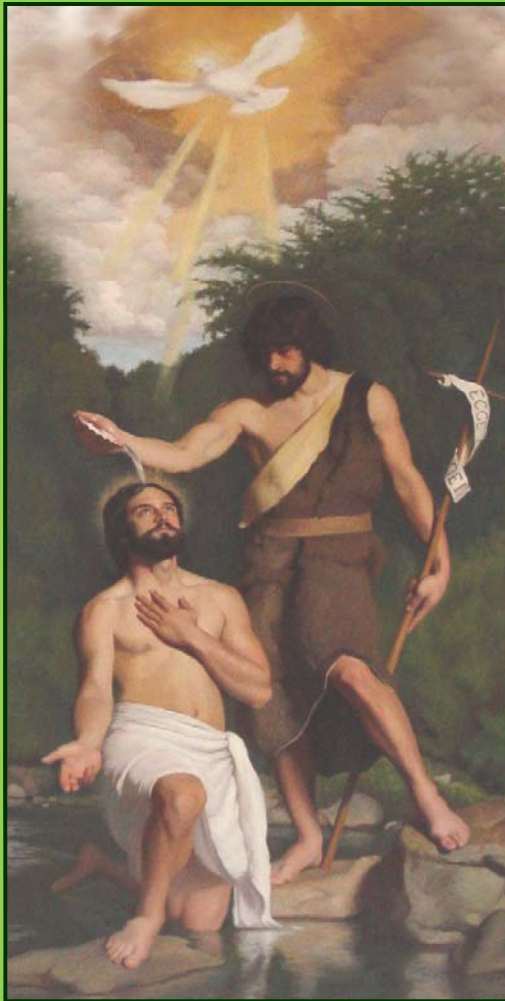

**Liturgical Catechesis for the Week:** Today, the Church celebrates the Second Sunday in Ordinary Time, a time when, according to the *General Norms for the Liturgical Year and the Calendar*, "no particular aspect of the mystery of Christ is celebrated, but rather the mystery of Christ itself is honored in its fullness, especially on Sundays."

Rather than thinking that Ordinary Time means "ordinary" as we might use the word in English, let us consider these days as "ordered" toward our daily devotion to Christ as we "work out your own salvation with fear and trembling; for God is at work in you, both to will and to work for his good pleasure" (Phil 2:12-13). Today in the Prayer after Communion, the Church prays: "Pour on us, O Lord, the Spirit of your love, and in your kindness make those you have nourished by this one heavenly Bread one in mind and heart." This prayer teaches us that while the principle fruit of holy Communion is "an intimate union with Christ Jesus" (CCC 1391), another fruit of reception of this Sacrament is that "Communion renews, strengthens, and deepens this incorporation into the Church," fulfilling our vocation to form one Body in Christ (CCC 1396). As St Paul writes, "Because there is one bread, we who are many are one body, for we all partake of the one bread" (1 Cor 10:17). "To that which you are," St Augustine preached, "you respond, *Amen*...Be then a member of the Body of Christ that your *Amen* may be true" (*Sermo 272*).
