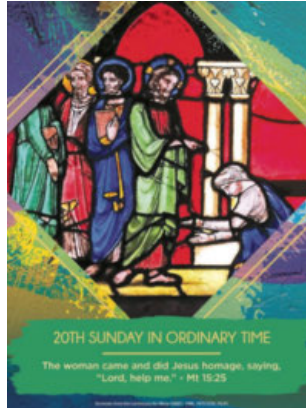

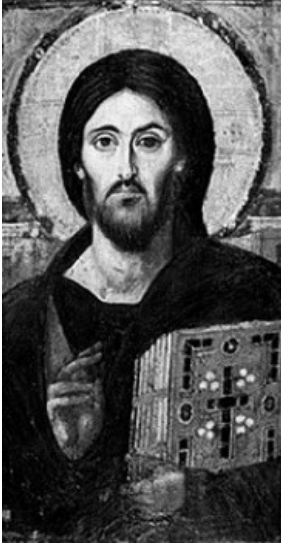

Save the date! Bishop Burbidge will visit us on **Saturday, September 23, at 10:30am**, to celebrate Holy Mass and confirm our parish's confirmation candidates. Rehearsal will be on **Tues, Sept 19, 5:30pm**. Parents of *confirmandi* should have received an important email about Confirmation. If you didn't receive it, please contact David: dwallace@sjtb.org.

Enrollment for our **Catechesis of the Good Shepherd** (for ages 3-12) program, as well as for Confirmation preparation class (grades 7-8) is now open. Please visit the parish website and click on Faith Formation. Hurry! Space is limited.

In view of our upcoming Confirmation, let us finish our review of this Sacrament in CCC (part 7): "The *original minister* of Confirmation is the bishop. In the East, ordinarily the priest who baptizes also immediately confers Confirmation in

one and the same celebration. But he does so with sacred chrism consecrated by the patriarch or the bishop, thus expressing the apostolic unity of the Church whose bonds are strengthened by the sacrament of Confirmation. In the Latin Church, the same discipline applies to the Baptism of adults or to the reception into full communion with the Church of a person baptized in another Christian community that does not have valid Confirmation. *In the Latin Rite*, the ordinary minister of Confirmation is the bishop. If the need arises, the bishop may grant the faculty of administering Confirmation to priests, although it is fitting that he confer it himself, mindful that the celebration of Confirmation has been temporally separated from Baptism for this reason. Bishops are the successors of the apostles. They have received the fullness of the sacrament of Holy Orders. The administration of this sacrament by them demonstrates clearly that its effect is to unite those who receive it more closely to the Church, to her apostolic origins, and to her mission of bearing witness to Christ. If a Christian is in danger of death, any priest can give him Confirmation. Indeed the Church desires that none of her children, even the youngest, should depart this world without having been perfected by the Holy Spirit with the gift of Christ's fullness." (CCC 1312-1314)

VOCATIONS

When the Son on the Cross promises paradise in his company to the good thief, when he promises the future feast in Heaven to the Apostles, when he speaks of the kingdom of the Father, he is always pointing toward eternity. 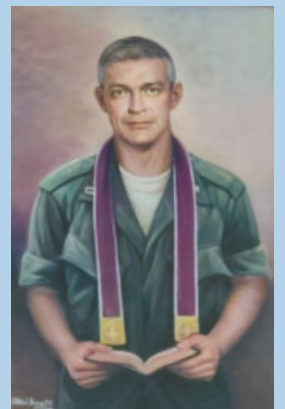

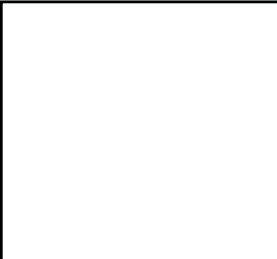
