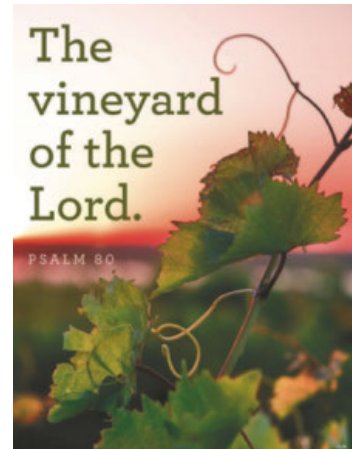

Deacon Sunday

Today, October 8, is Deacon Sunday! Parishes across the US and Canada observe this day as a day to inspire vocations to the diaconate and affirm deacons and their families. Deacons play a pivotal role in daily parish life, which, depending on the parish, could have them proclaiming the Gospel, delivering homilies, performing baptisms, visiting the sick, and more. The men called to this vocation are prepared to handle these responsibilities over a five-year formation period that ends with their ordination. Eucharistic Rosary Congress Continues
