





Why the name FIAT? "FIAT" is a Latin word for "Let it be done." It was Mary's response to the angel Gabriel when she was asked to become the mother of Jesus. "Let it be done unto me according to Your Will" refers to Mary's "Yes" to God.

The effects of original sin entice us to withhold some part of ourselves from God, but Saint Paul reminds us: "You were chosen by God our Father." Thus, the one to whom we owe everything is not a tyrannical ruler, but our Creator who loves us.


