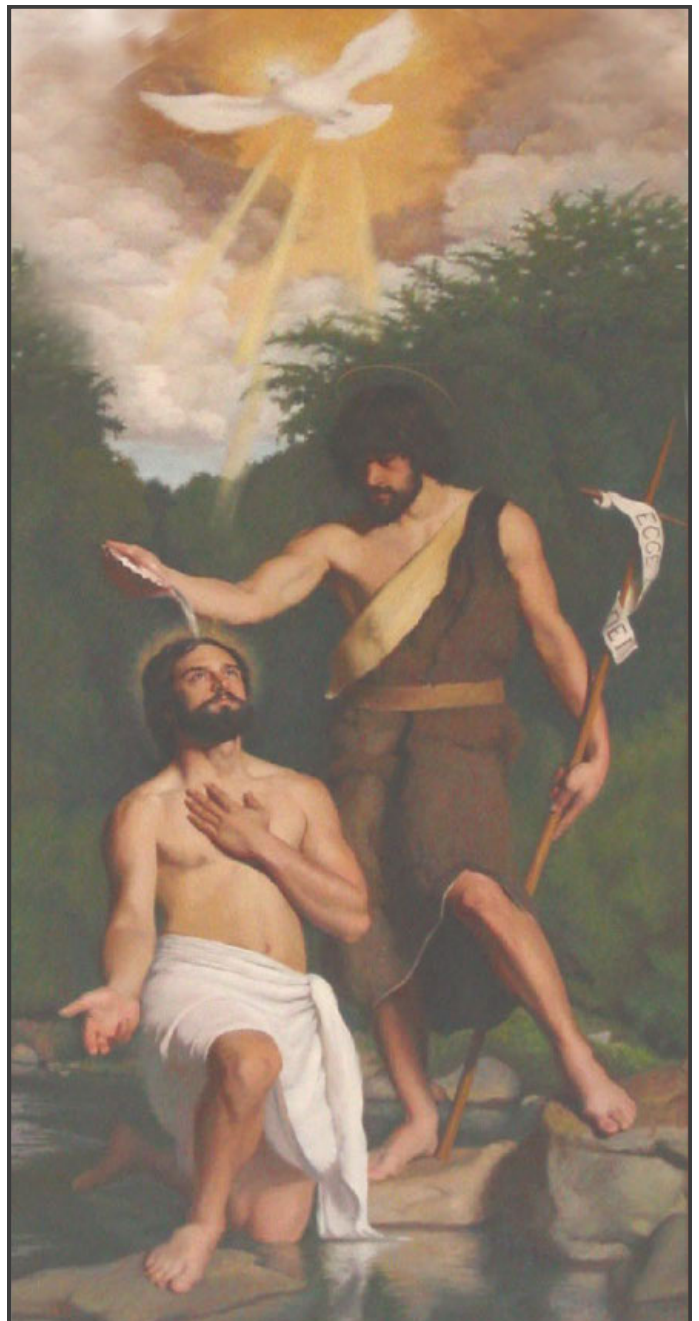

It makes me happy to suffer for you, as I am suffering now, and in my own body to do what I can to make up all that is still to be undergone by Christ for the sake of His Body, the Church. Col 1:24

In the evening, these souls came and asked me to pray for them, and I did pray very much for them. In the evening when the procession was returning from the cemetery, I saw a great multitude of souls walking with us into the chapel and praying with us. I prayed a good deal, for I had my superior's permission to do so."

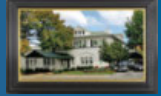
