

Vocation Awareness

The Christian married couple, with their children, form an image of the Trinitarian God: Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Marriage and family life images the Trinity in two ways.

- 1. Marriage is a communion of love between co-equal persons, beginning with husband and wife and extending to all the members of the family.
- 2. Just as Trinity's love is life-giving, a married couple's love conceives and cares for children.

The family is a microcosm of the Church. Parents have a special responsibility to teach children the faith and help them to grow in virtue. The family matures by participating in the life and worship of the larger Church, especially Sunday Eucharist. In the Eucharist, members of the family are most fully united to Christ, to one another, and to their brothers and sisters throughout the world.

Marriage is a vocation, or divine call, as necessary and valuable to the Church as other vocations. Discernment of and preparation for marriage is a process that begins early in life and continues through the engagement period.
