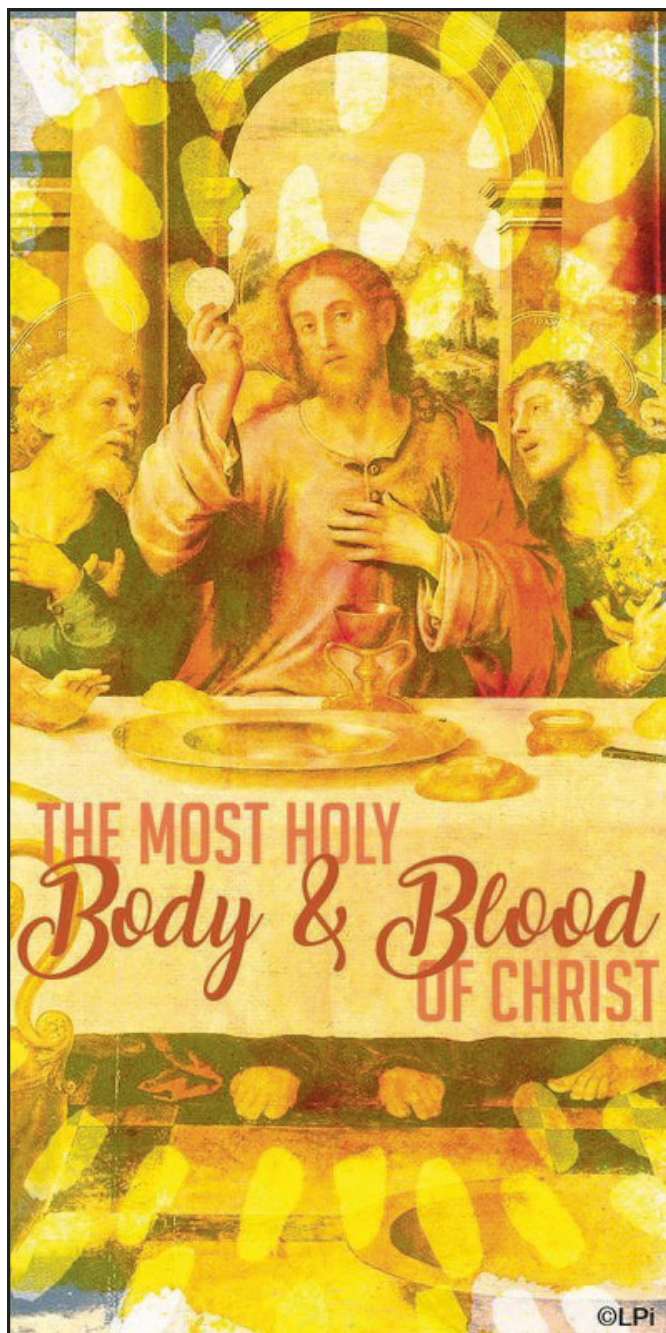

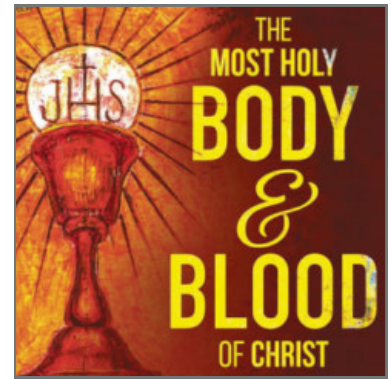

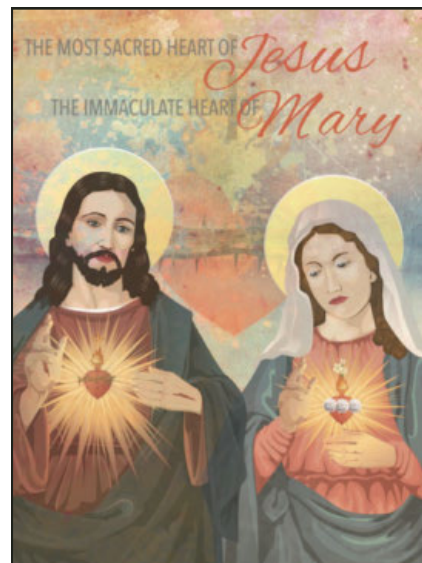

- takes our prayer of praise and thanks to the heavenly altar and who shares with us his Body and Blood (Liturgy of the Eucharist).
- commissions us to go forth to continue his saving work in the world (Concluding Rites).

The Holy Spirit is also present in our community worship helping us to open our minds and hearts to God and to each other, helping us to worship God in spirit and truth.

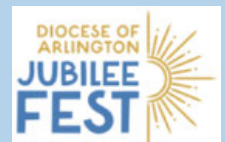
Diocesan Jubilee Festival: Saturday, June 8, 2024

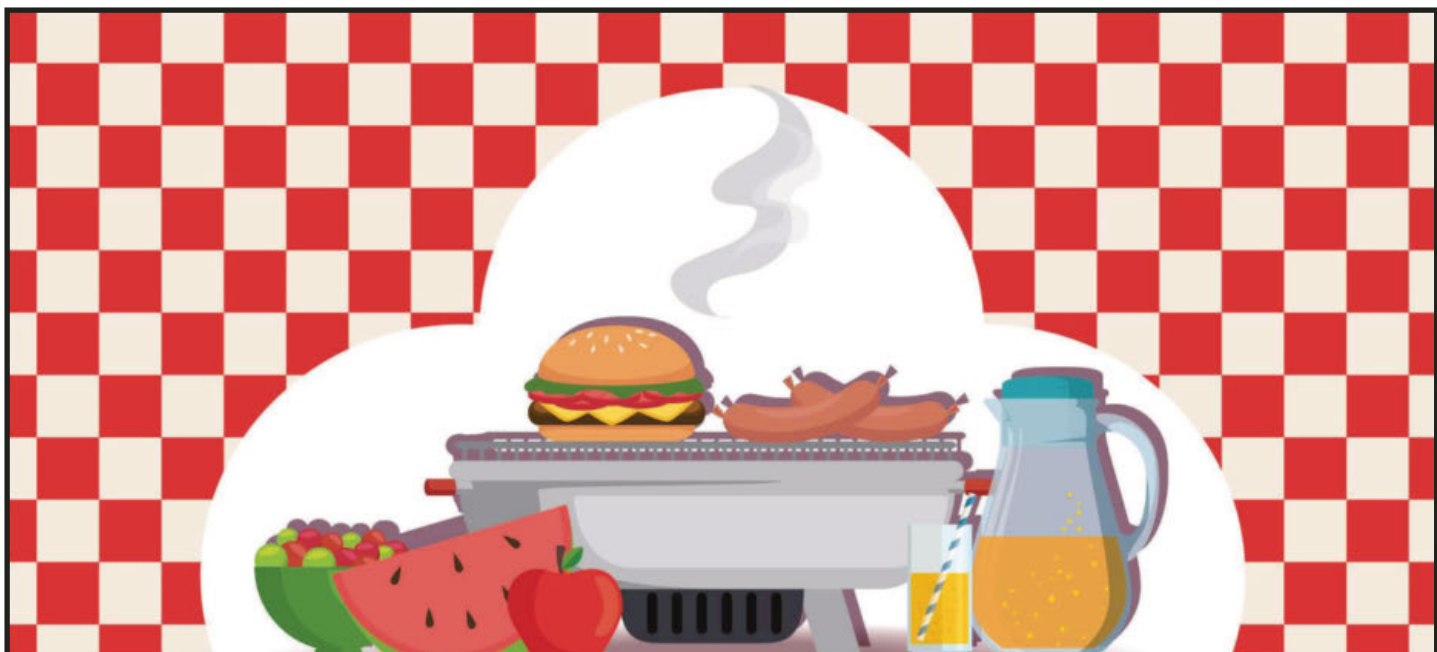

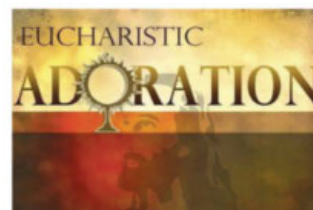
