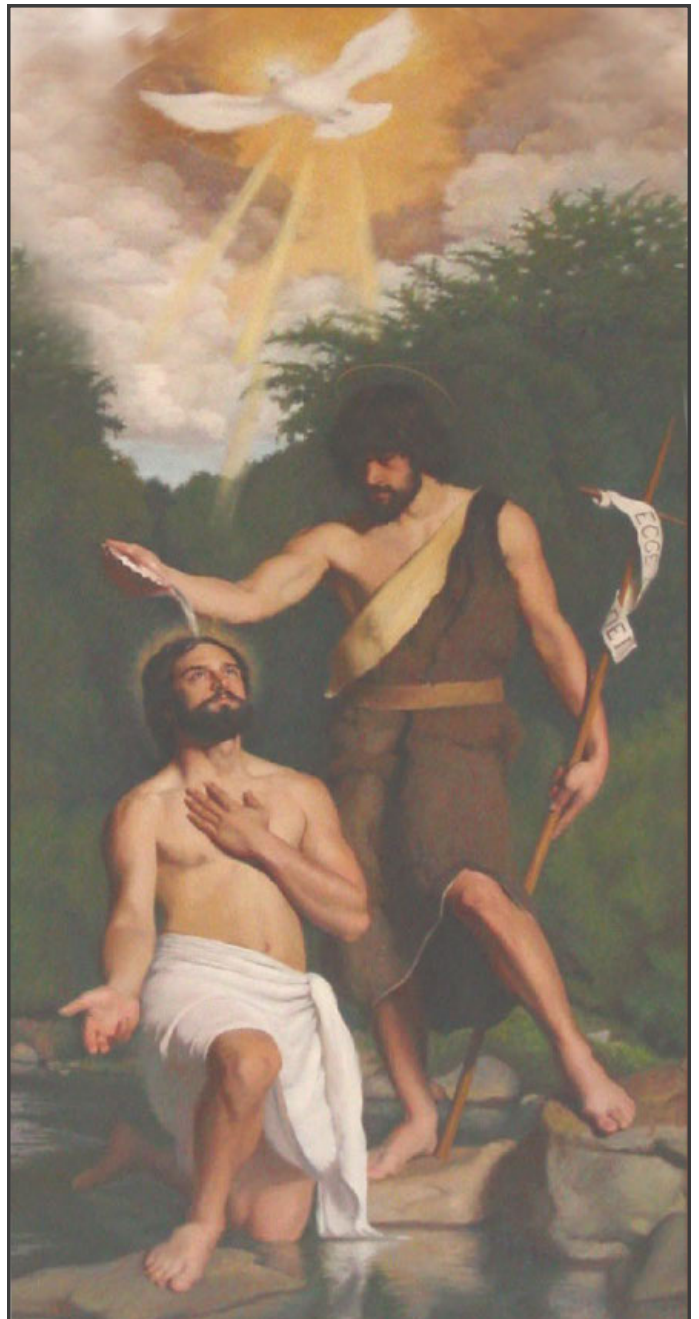

Seek the Kingdom of God above all else, and live righteously, and he will give you everything you need. Matt 6:33

7 tips to slow down and refocus on Christ:

1. Stop Distractions -Cultivate a spirit of stillness and attentiveness to his voice.
2. Morning Devotionals -Start the day with surrender, gratitude, and dependence on God.
3. Prayer Walks -Behold God's invisible qualities, eternal power, and divine nature through what has been made.
4. Fasting -Means of repentance and spiritual renewal, humble ourselves before God, seek his forgiveness, and turn away from sin.
5. Practice Gratitude -Shift our focus to God's abundant grace and provision, reflecting our desire to honor and glorify his name, shaping our attitudes, actions, and relationships.
6. Read Classic Christian Books -Learn from the spiritual journeys and insights of Christian leaders and thinkers throughout history, emulate their faith and connect to the wider Body of Christ across time.
7. Journaling -Record God's faithfulness, answered prayers, and personal experiences of his presence and provision.

Most importantly, read God's word.

Jesus is our life, the source of joy, peace, and all we long for. Let's set aside the distractions and fears to find a deeper life in him.
