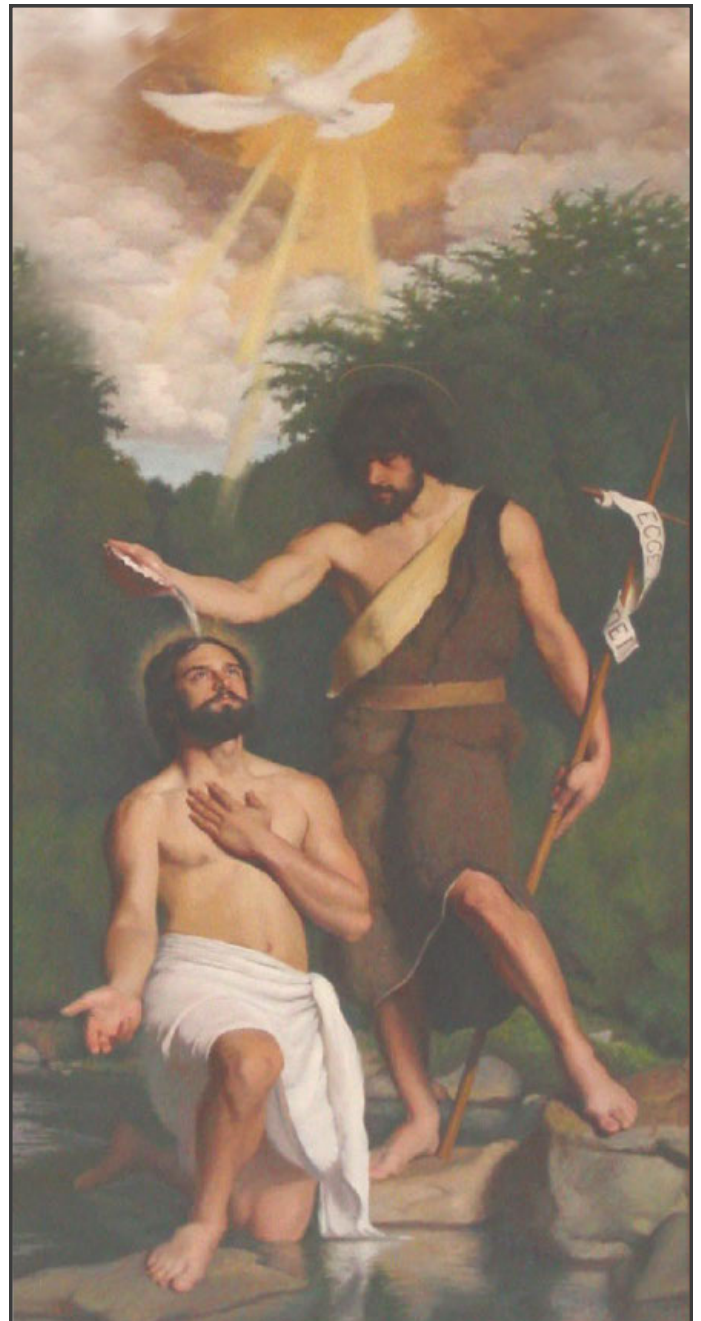

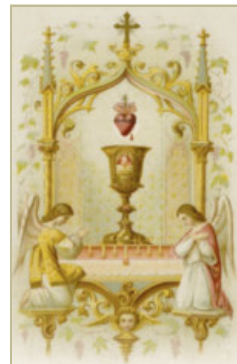
Month of the Precious Blood

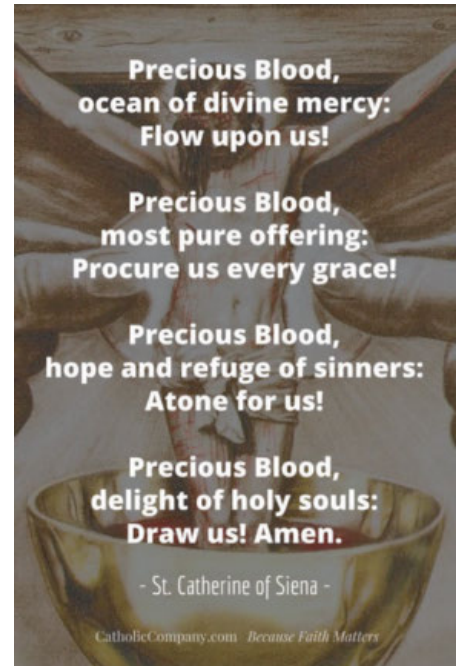

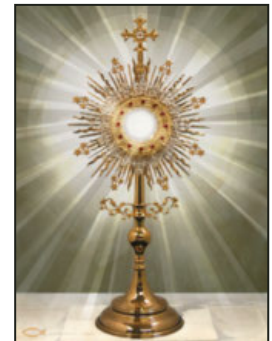
