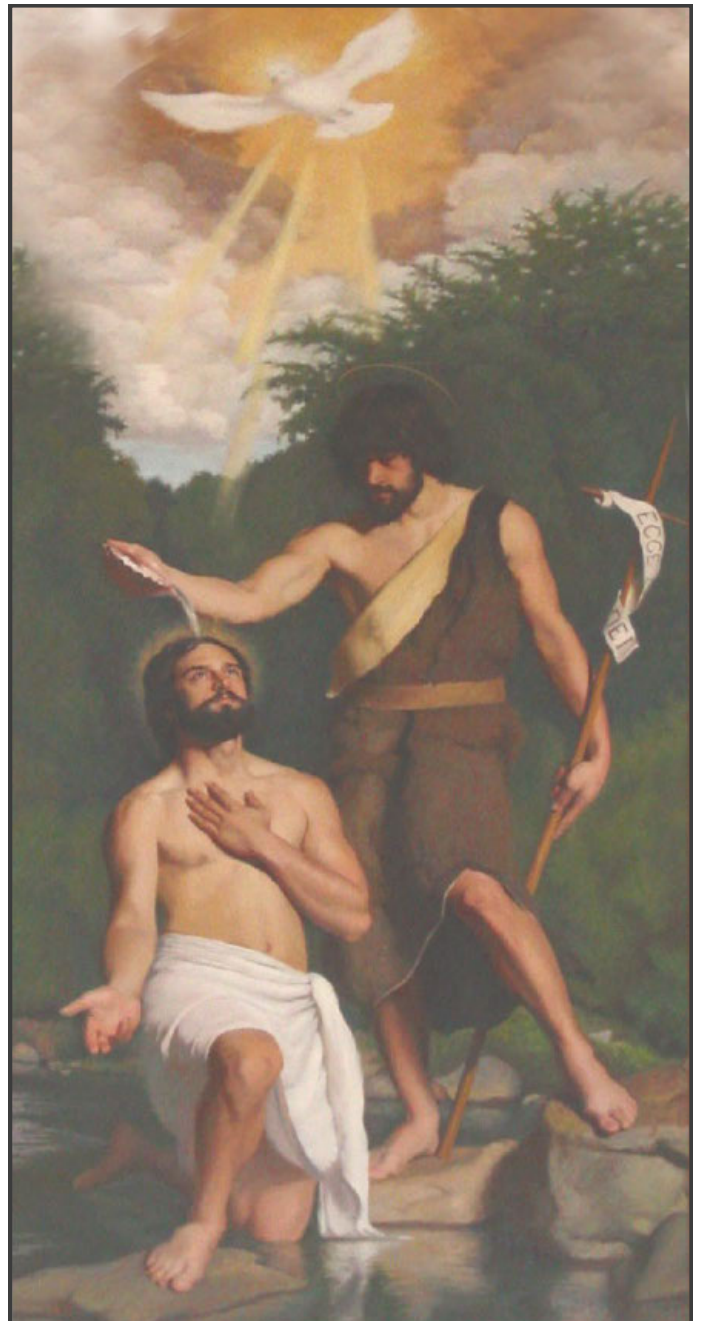

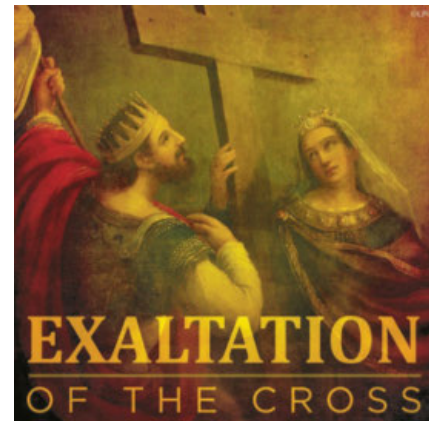

Vocation Awareness

10 Things To Teach Your Kids About Being Catholic Before They Leave Home

1. You are a beloved son/daughter of the King. Your identity is centered in Jesus Christ.
2. You are seen, known, and loved. God truly knows you and loves you without condition.
3. When the noise of the world is too much, Jesus quite literally waits for you in the quiet at any Catholic Church. Remember that red light of Christ you learned about as a child – He's still there. Go sit with Him.
4. When you feel alone in a struggle, connect with a Saint, ask them to intercede for you.
5. Pray the Memorare, Mary will lead you to Jesus.
6. When you don't feel connected plug into local volunteer opportunities, see Jesus in others.
7. Remember the power and grace in the sacraments. Confession brings healing, the Eucharist strengthens.
8. Pray, every day. Offer gratitude to God, ask for help, have a conversation with Him.
9. You have a unique calling from God, ask him to help you discern it. Cooperate with your guardian angel.
10. Go to Mass – your spiritual anchor and community, where you receive sacramental graces and Jesus waits for you.

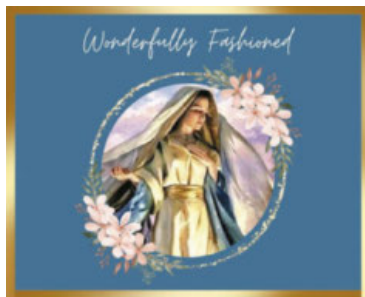
